

TASK ORGANIZATION: MCB SIX (Herein known as the Battalion)

1. SITUATION . Normal rotation of personnel within the Naval Construction Battalions requires a continuous training program to maintain the desired degree of readiness. Accordingly, it is necessary to move approximately 180 men of the Battalion from the U.S. Naval Construction Battalion Center, Davisville, R.I. to the U.S. Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, N.C. in September 1965 for general military training under the following conditions:

a. Enemy forces . None.

b. Friendly forces.

c. Detachments . Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company.

2. MISSION . Pursuant to reference (a), the Battalion is to deploy a Provisional Rifle/Weapons Company of approximately 180 men to CAMLEJ in conjunction with general military training and the use of crew-served weapons.

3. EXECUTION . When directed in September 1965, the Company shall deploy from CBC Davisville to CAMLEJ as an Attachment to MCB FOUR for a period of approximately four weeks. During the deployment, the Company will be maintained in the same readiness condition as the Battalion.

4. ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS:

- a. The standard operational procedures set forth by reference (b) will be followed.
- b. Leave shall be administered in accordance with reference (c).
- c. Equipment assignments are made by Annex B.

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5. COMMAND AND SIGNAL :

a. The Commanding Officer will direct the Company to report to the Commanding Officer, MCB FOUR on 8 September 1965 for operational control. Return of OPCON of the Company to the Battalion shall be made upon the Company's return to Davisville.

b. Authority to deploy an Advance Party is hereby granted.

c. The Battalion is authorized direct liaison with the MARCORBASE, [CAMLEJ] and component activities.





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ANNEX B  
USN EQUIPMENT ASSIGNMENT

1. The USN equipment authorized for deployment with the Battalion at CAMLEJ is listed by the EAM listing.
2. Any item of USN equipment in the custody of the Battalion for this field training and not listed shall be reported. A verified copy of the list shall be returned to COMCBLANT Code 41 promptly.
3. Reference (a) sets forth the responsibilities for custody, maintenance, and disposition of the equipment. Reference (b) sets forth the requirements for control and management reporting of the equipment monthly.
4. Upon completion of the field training at CAMLEJ, the equipment listed shall be promptly returned to the CBLANT Motor Pool at Bldg. 126, CBC Davisville. At that time, the Battalion will conduct a joint inspection in conjunction with the CBLANT Training Department to effect a sub-custody transfer. Necessary forms for this transfer action will be furnished by COMCBLANT Code 41. A copy of the executed form on each piece of USN equipment must be returned to COMCBLANT. At the time of sub-custody transfer, a completed Shop Repair Order (NAVDOCKS 1948) will be submitted for each piece of equipment showing parts required (by manufacturers' part number) and work necessary to place it in 0-1 condition to the CBLANT Training Department.
5. The EAM listing will be forwarded to the Battalion under separate cover.

PUBLIC INFORMATION

1. MISSION. Collect and disseminate public information material that will illustrate the defensive military posture and smartness of today's Seabees.

2. EXECUTION:

a. The release of public information material in connection with this deployment shall be in accordance with the provisions of references (a) and (b).

b. Extreme care must be exercised to ensure that public information releases conform with the following:

(1) Do not make reference to any aspect of the deployment which may be considered classified.


(2) Do not contain any material which may reflect with discredit on the United States or any branch of the U.S. Armed Forces.

(3) Do not contain any material which tends to degrade or ridicule the customs or living conditions of the area where deployed.
