Adult Tour Reservation Form



- 1. Guided tours are available for adults on a first-come, first-serve basis. Included in this category are all students from grade nine and up.
- 2. Fully completed adult tour reservation forms must be submitted no later than two weeks before the tour date. If the form is submitted less than two weeks before the requested guided tour date, groups will be directed to guide the museum as a visitor at their own leisure.
- 3. Once the museum receives a fully completed adult tour reservation form, the estimated processing time for tour schedule requests is three to five business days.
- 4. A tour group must have a minimum of ten (10) attendees. An NMAS representative will contact the group at least 48 hours ahead of the tour date to confirm the number of attendees. Should the group size fall below the required minimum, the group will be automatically shifted to a self-guided visit.
